

# Checklist for 2012 ASL Immersion Camp at OCD

## It will be helpful if you bring:

- Unscented body products (one of our ASL Instructors has allergies to scented products including scented deodorant, body mists and perfumes... Please respect this and try and make our camp week "scent free"!)
- Flashlight (and batteries)
- Insect repellent
- Sun tan lotion & after sun lotion
- Medicine
- Slippers for the dormitory & the classroom
- Warm clothing
- Slip-on sandals (in the classroom, shoes are not permitted therefore it'd be easier to have a pair of slip-on sandals)
- Be prepared for rainy day
- A fan for hot nights in the dorm
- Waist pouch to keep valuables (i.e. cash, id, keys) with you
- A STRONG RESPECT FOR OUR NO-VOICE RULE IN ORDER TO GET THE MOST OUT OF OUR ASL IMMERSION CAMP!!!!

## Don't forget to bring:

- Signing Naturally Student Workbook. This is not mandatory but you will find it helpful. Material may be shared. You are welcome to purchase your material at camp by **Cheque or Cash**.
- Sleeping bag (or sheet and blankets) -- you may wish to bring a twin size foam egg carton for additional comfort on the bunks!
- Pillow
- Towels (for everyday use and swimming)
- Personal necessities
- Sunglasses, hat
- Bottle for water (Please put your name on it!).

## Transportation:

## From the south:

- Highway 400 north of Barrie
- You will pass an exit to highway 141 to Huntsville.
- Take the next exit, # 213 to Old Highway 69 South.
- Turn Right; go down the hill to the first right.
- Turn right onto BLACKSTONE AND CRANE LAKE ROAD and follow the signs for 5 km to the Ontario Camp of the Deaf.
