DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES

<u>Adult Residential Services</u> include residential services for individuals 18+ with a developmental disability and/or dual diagnosis (developmental disability and mental health issue). Individuals must be deemed eligible and be registered with Developmental Services Ontario (DSO). Services available in Milton and Toronto.

<u>Adult Community Programs</u> include work activities and/or supported employment, supported independent living, respite options and community supports that focus on social/recreational and life skill development.

Services available in Milton and Toronto.

<u>Youth Mental Health Program</u> includes counselling and referral services to youth. Although located in Milton, virtual services are available on-line.

EDUCATION SERVICES

<u>Sign Language Services</u> provide American Sign Language training and classes and various immersion opportunities (summer camp / retreats/ Immersion weeks).

<u>EarlyON Child and Family Centre</u> is a drop-in, interactive environment where Deaf, hard of hearing, and hearing parents and caregivers connect with each other and learn new ways to stimulate their children's development through play. Services available in Toronto

<u>Adult Education</u> services for deaf clients including; Language Instructions for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) and Literacy and Basic Skills (LBS) Services available in Toronto

SENIORS' SERVICES

<u>Assisted living program</u> for housing and a range of fully funded services such as PSW, congregate dining, transportation, activation and communication and community outreach. The City of Toronto supports our Assisted Living Program with a number of Rent-Geared-to-Income subsidies. Services available in Toronto

<u>Toronto Deaf Seniors Centre (TDSC)</u> provides educational, social and recreation activities in an environment of Deaf culture, language and heritage. Services available in Toronto
